# **Water Chestnut Update**

Neither Jim McNamee of Wedowaterweeds nor Hockney have Not returned phone calls. Overington proposed getting a \$8000 8 ? foot wide harvester from alphaboats.com. We may have a 15-foot-long boat to pull it, otherwise, we would buy one. We have a possible donor for both. Overington and Christian will take on this project and hopefully, we will have it for next year. The town maintenance crew is not allowed to work on the water, but the town might maintain and store the machine. Volunteers would do the harvesting with motorized sickle.

Water chestnut picking will take place on Saturday, June 18 at 10 AM. Do we need a waiver and can we use the same one that the Kayak Tour is using?
