Ice House Landing

Overington will ask Anthony Cidras to put boulders at Ice House Landing. Discussion followed on what kind of access and activities do we want at Ice House Landing - campsites for the Hudson River Greenway Water Trail, kayak launching, boat launching. Discussion on auto access at the site and kayak/boat launching from the site.

Overington will present the Ice House Landing plan at the Town Board meeting.

The Right of Way

Amtrak can't block out cars on the Right of Way because the state owns a portion of the row on the water side of the tracks. We don't want to encourage driving on the ROW.

Overington foresees a meeting of the WAC and LWRP. This will help us determine what our further interests should be. LWRP is developing harbormanagement laws for Germantown.
